IMPORTANT: Lifetime licenses issued after 12/31/82 do not allow the applicants to hunt with bow and arrow or to trap. For these privileges, licenses can be purchased by qualified persons.

No license to hunt with firearms shall be issued to any person unless he held a resident license to hunt with firearms within five years from the date of application in any state or country or possession thereof, or unless he presents to the Town Clerk a certificate of competency issued by the Connecticut Conservation Education/Firearms Safety Program. Requirements for such certificate may be waived in lieu of the following affirmation.

I, the undersigned, affirm that I have previously held a resident (Firearms Hunting) or (Combination License) that included the firearms hunting privilege.

I declare under the penalties of false statement as provided by Section 53a-157 of the Connecticut Statutes that the statements herein made by me are true and correct. I also declare that my right to obtain the license applied for is not void or under suspension.

(Any person who violates the provisions of Section 53a-157 of the Connecticut General Statutes or who shall procure another to do so shall be imprisoned not more than one year and fined up to one thousand dollars.)

Connecticut residents over 65 years of age may apply for a lifetime firearms hunting, fishing license or combination thereof, without payment of fee. The Town Clerk or Agent shall indicate on the license the specific purpose for which it is issued.

Seasons, bag and creel limits, methods of taking, lands and waters open to public hunting, trapping and fishing and other pertinent information, is contained in the Hunting and Trapping Field Guide or Connecticut Angler's Guide booklets. Available at offices of the Town Clerk or Agents and at the office of the Department of Environmental Protection.
