- **b.** P&Z Liaison: Elby Burr reported that the P&Z committee recently approved new regulations specifically related to Senior Housing in Salem.

- **a.** Wendy Mikolinski reported that Selectman Kevin Lyden had approved an official Facebook page for the EDC Committee to be used for Salem EDC activity and announcements. This page will also be used as a tool to gather data from area businesses to be included in the Salem Business Directory.

- **b.** Elby Burr presented the Senior Housing Project to the EDC members. His thorough presentation included examples of existing senior housing developments in surrounding areas. Elby used these examples to produce a template of a senior development that would blend into Salem's rural environment and meet the new regulations passed by the P&Z Committee.

His design included a circular freestanding home design with a common road leading into the neighborhood. To comply with Salem's regulations, including water, sewer, and leach field requirements, the neighborhood would have 8 units with private driveways and shared sewer, water and leach field systems. Elby produced an aerial layout design of the proposed neighborhood for the EDC members to use as a guide during his presentation.

The EDC members unanimously approved of Elby's design. Elby will request a meeting with Selectman Kevin Lyden and Town Planner Rich Serra to present his design on behalf of the EDC Committee and to discuss possible land sources for the project. Elby will report updates to the EDC members at the next EDC meeting.
