The Commissioners reviewed and discussed the proposal received by Shawn Callaghan (DBA Earthview Design) for the Disc Golf Course Project. The total estimated amount for his fees is \$5,006.00, half to be paid upon the start of the project and the remaining half to be paid upon the completion of the project. Discussion ensued regarding the procedure for forming a Salem Recreation Association (SRA), an independent organization. Should they not be able to receive any grant funding, the Commission felt that they would still be able to work on the project through in-kind contributions and for minimal cost for any necessary materials.

M/S/C: Maziarz/Fresco-Hawes, to allocate \$2,500.00 to Shawn Callaghan (DBA Earthview Design) to begin the Disc Golf Project, from their FY2019/20 budget. Discussion: None. Voice vote, 5-0, all in favor.

5. Basketball Program Backboard Quote from Jaypro

The estimate for the basketball backboards was provided to and reviewed by the Commission, for their information. The backboards will provide an additional semi-full court set of adjustable basketball hoops and replace the portable backboards they are currently using.
