## **OVERSIZE HOUSEHOLD "BULKY WASTE" AMNESTY DAYS**

e.g. COUCHES, TABLES, HOUSEHOLD ITEMS, ETC.

THESE ITEMS NORMALLY EACH HAVE A CHARGE, BUT WILL BE ACCEPTED FREE

**\*\*Mattresses, Electronics and Metal are Free Every day!\*\***

**[Does not include cfc-containing appliances, construction or demo materials]**

**SUNDAY – October 18<sup>th</sup>, 2020**

**WEDNESDAY – October 21<sup>st</sup>, 2020**

Due to the ongoing COVID-19 Pandemic the following steps will be implemented for Amnesty/Bulky Waste Days.

- 1. Residents will be responsible to unload their own vehicles.**
- 2. Proper distancing between vehicles is required**
- 3. Masks must be worn**
- 4. Do not bring mattresses, metal or electronics on Amnesty Days.**

**These items are free. Bring them any other day.**

## RECYCLING IN SALEM..... EVERYONE'S RESPONSIBILITY

### ACCEPTABLE SINGLE STREAM RECYCLABLES:

- Newspapers, inserts, magazines, brochures, junk mail
- Paper bags, paperboard boxes (cereal, egg cartons)
- Phone books, catalogs, hard and soft cover books
- White or colored paper, envelopes (window OK), school paper
- File folders, shredded paper, multi three-ply paper
- Glass containers
- Tin cans, small metal items
- Aluminum cans, foil, aluminum pots and pans
- Juice and milk cartons
- Plastic milk jugs and plastic soda bottles
- Plastic buckets and crates
- Detergent bottles
- All plastics #1 - #7
- Empty aerosol cans
- **No Styrofoam #6**
- **No trash or dirty paper products**

### CORRUGATED CARDBOARD:

Clean, corrugated cardboard - basically boxes which have been flattened.

### SCRAP METAL:

Metal parts from bicycles, cars, lawnmowers, stripped of all non-metal parts & such metal items as iron rods and pipes, wire coat hangers, screws, nails, etc.

**NO:** Food cans/containers, paint cans or propane gas containers.

### WASTE OIL:

Petroleum products (such as motor oil) used for lubrication and hydraulic applications in one (1) to five (5) gallon containers.

**NO:** Gasoline, diesel fuel or cooking oils/fuels.

**DO NOT USE CONTAINERS FROM BLEACH OR CHLORINE PRODUCTS.**

### ANTIFREEZE:

"Clean", non-contaminated used antifreeze in gallon containers.

### TIRES: (Only tires off rim accepted)

Car and light truck tires require a \$2.00 disposal fee. Large truck tires (47" high or 12" wide) require a \$10.00 disposal fee.

### BATTERIES:

Car, truck -lead acid only

**NO:** Alkaline batteries.

### OVERSIZED (BULKY) HOUSEHOLD TRASH:

A fee of \$10.00 per item is charged for residential items such as a sofa and stuffed chair and small items will be \$5.00.

### BRUSH (under 3" in diameter):

Free disposal for residents/homeowners/non-commercial vehicles. \$10.00 per cubic yard for commercial haulers. **NOTE:** Compost material (leaves, grass clippings, etc.) are **NOT ACCEPTED**.

### DEMOLITION/CONSTRUCTION MATERIALS:

See the operator. A fee by volume (minimum of \$5.00) is charged to dispose of used lumber, plywood, doors, door/window frames, etc. Asphalt shingles/other \$20.00 per cubic yard. Some items may require showing a building or demolition permit. Permit or Letter of Exemption required from the Building Department.
