Earlier this month, the "In Person & Public" Memorial Day Parade and Service on the Salem Town Green was CANCELED due to the COVID-19 outbreak.

Many towns are simply canceling all Memorial Day events. Committee members never imagined a scenario that would require the cancellation of our Memorial Day Parade.

In honor of Memorial Day, we developed an alternative and will bring this year's parade to your neighborhoods. Parade participants and routing were greatly limited due to safety issues.

Memorial Day commemorates our fellow citizen soldiers, both women and men who died while in the military service of the United States of America; particularly those who died in combat or as a result of wounds or injuries sustained in combat.

We live in gratitude for their precious gift of freedom.
