The following is an update on Winter Storm Bailey.

This was a significant Winter Storm of nearly 10 inches of snowfall in Salem.

The Emergency Operation Center was opened at 7pm Wednesday evening and operated by our EOC staff until closing at 12 noon today.

Our Eversource Representative monitored our Town through the Storm and reported no significant power issues.

The Town had 6 plow trucks on the road through the Winter Storm. Public Work Crews worked through the night and into today clearing our 44 miles of roads.

Thank you to the Gardner Lake Fire Company for preparing breakfast for our Public Works and EOC staff this morning.

Our Public Works Crews will be salting the roads in the next few hours as well as plowing Salem School.

We are fortunate for the hard work and dedication of our Public Works.
